Q. Stephan, you got off to a fast start today but after bogeying 7, things slowed down a little bit. What's your assessment now of today's 66?

STEPHAN JAEGER: Well, it slowed down because Nos. 8, 9 and 10 are probably the three hardest holes on the golf course. I feel like I played nice. You know, obviously the bogey on 7 kind of hurt. That's kind of one that hit a good drive, it's pretty much automatic birdie so kind of a two-shot swing there.

Other than that, I gave myself some nice looks, hit a bunch of lips, but I'm in a great spot tomorrow. This golf course, like you said, you kind of come out and make some birdies early and put some pressure on 'em and you've just got to go through that 8 through 10 stretch, 11 stretch unscathed and you have a chance to make a couple coming in. Even though 16, 17, they're hard holes, so you've got to make the birdies where you can and make pars on those holes.

Q. How did the course play in comparison to the first two days?

STEPHAN JAEGER: I felt like it was a little windier this afternoon, but I also feel like I just didn't quite play -- drove it not as well today as I have the last couple days. I'm happy with my round for sure.

Q. Finally, you're third trailing by three heading into Sunday. Last year you were T-20 finishing fifth -- third, so you know how to put on a good final round here and hopefully it will be tomorrow.

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah. Listen, I've been playing nice and to be able to have a chance on Sunday's kind of what we practice for. I'm excited for tomorrow. I'll get some rest and come out strong tomorrow.
