ROB OPPENHEIM

Q. Rob, bogey-free 6 under today, what was working well with the game today and how were you able to keep it clean?

ROB OPPENHEIM: Yeah, it was a solid start. It's a very fun golf course, I enjoy playing out here. It's tricky, got to keep it in the fairway. The greens firmed up a little bit. Some tricky pins. Made some key up-and-downs when I had to and I was out of position. Yeah, great start.

Q. You mentioned the course is fun to play, Alister MacKenzie design. What is it you like about it and what makes it a tricky course, even though it's not the longest course?

ROB OPPENHEIM: Hopefully -- you know, we haven't had any rain today or the last couple days, so hopefully it firms up, and if it firms up, it will play really tricky just because you have angles, big slopes to the greens. You can be right by the green and almost impossible if you're in the wrong spot. You've got to think your way around here. You're going to have a lot of wedges, but you've really got to attack the pin at the right angle and then you've obviously got to make some putts. I enjoy playing golf courses like this. It's great to be here.

Q. You've made the cut the first four events this year. What's been working well with the game to start the year and where do you think kind of that consistency's been coming from?

ROB OPPENHEIM: Yeah, it's been a good start. Yeah, playing consistent. I think the most important thing is I feel healthy. The last couple years I've kind of dealt with -- I've had shoulder surgery and then kind of dealt with some things with the elbow. So I feel better than I've felt the last couple years, so that's nice to start the year kind of playing back to I wouldn't say 100 percent, but feeling healthy.

Q. So what did you do like over the offseason? Were you kind of taking it easy then?

ROB OPPENHEIM: Yeah.

Q. Just getting the body right?

ROB OPPENHEIM: Yeah, doing some more physical therapy. Yeah, but took some time.



Off, after the season I took about a month off, spent some time with my wife and kids. You're gone so much and I've got a 12-year-old and a 9-year-old so did a lot of games and some rest, and as the season got closer kind of -- needed to go to Q-School, I just took a rest and kind of took three months to kind of recover and get ready for the year.
