MATTHEW ANDERSON (-12)



Q. Matt, 61 today. It took about 12 hours but broke the course record here. Just take us through today and how you were able to refocus during all those breaks.

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Yeah, just kind of show up, show up when they ask you to is really all you can do. You know, I'm no stranger to -- weather delays obviously happen and you go in, chill out, take your mind off the golf and then refocus when your time's called. It's just all I try to do really.

Q. How did you spend those breaks today?

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Gosh, the first one, five hours, I was in the lounge for a bit just hanging out, booking some flights, preparing for some upcoming travel.

Then just hanging out with Chase in the lounge for a bit outside, ate two lunches. Just kind of hung around, I guess.

Q. How did your game feel today? What was working well for you that you were kind of able to get around here so well bogey free?

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Yeah, I mean, putter, obviously anytime you shoot a low number you're probably going to be putting pretty well. I was giving myself a lot of looks, hitting my irons solid. You know, even kind of from -- I hit a few wayward today and just was kind of able to make it work, get myself in position, hit a good shot from there and just make putts. That's how I would describe it, I guess.

Q. What's been your thoughts about this course and how's it changed throughout just today with all the weather and rain that's come through?

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Yeah, obviously I was told that this course can play pretty firm in the past. Obviously with all the rain that we've had this week I knew that wasn't really going to be the case. The greens were soft earlier this week as well, yesterday into this morning, and then obviously after the rain the greens are just going to get a little slower, you're going to get some spin. You've just got to play for it.

Fairways held up pretty well. Yeah, you've just got to play for it, learn as you go.



Q. The second restart you guys probably knew you were going to be pushing up against it, whether you were going to finish the round today. Was that in your group's round at all, trying to pick up the pace a little?

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Yeah, I mean, we wanted obviously to stay with the group in front of us as best we could, right, just to give us a chance of doing it. That's all you can do. But going up 17, like I asked the time and I think we had enough time, so I wasn't overly worried. Yeah, I think Jim rushed to the tee pretty quickly on 18.

Q. What's the plan tonight? You don't have to come back early tomorrow.

MATTHEW ANDERSON: Yeah, just get some dinner somewhere. I don't know where, talk to Chase about it, I guess. Yeah, hang out, call some family, read. I don't know, figure it out. Chill more into tomorrow.
