JUSTIN SUH (-23)

Q. Justin, it's been a long few days at the course but you came out on top. How does it feel and what's this week been like with all the interruptions and everything?

JUSTIN SUH: It feels great. From the start of the week we kind of knew it was going to be a hectic week. To stay patient through it all and come out with the score that I did, I'm extremely grateful that we got it in all four days. Just can't be happy enough to get the win, especially with The Open exemption on the line, there's a lot there riding on it. Overall just couldn't be happier.

Q. You mentioned The Open exemption. What does it mean to you to have the opportunity to go play in The Open Championship?

JUSTIN SUH: It means a lot. A couple years ago when I was playing well on the PGA TOUR, that was one of the majors I missed, so to get there through this exemption is really, really cool.

Q. And I guess you won out here a few years ago now. How does it feel? Does it feel any different than it did last time, or what does it feel like to be back in the winner's circle?

JUSTIN SUH: You know, I struggled with my game all last year, kind of went through a slump. Just kind of being on the other side of it now and to have worked on the things I've worked on with my coach and my team, just couldn't be more grateful to be in the position I'm in. Just to see the progress over the last four to five months has been really exciting.

Q. What were some of the things you were fighting during that slump?

JUSTIN SUH: It was just kind of a mix of being lost like with my swing. I just kept trying to find it week by week, trying something new and it just wasn't working.

We finally had a tournament where it just kind of clicked and since then kind of developed a system where I can just stay as consistent as I can and just have my procedure going through tournament to tournament. From where I was a few years back to now, I think I've learned a lot more, progressed as a golfer than I think -- I'm excited where the game's at.

Q. What do you think clicked for you?



JUSTIN SUH: Just being aware of the face really. Every -- most guys will say that's kind of the key to playing good golf; if you're aware of the face, you can swing confidently. I think that was just the key this week to the good ball-striking week that I had.

Q. The goal out here is to get back to the PGA TOUR for you. Is there anything really that you're focusing on or want to improve upon while you're down here?

JUSTIN SUH: Honestly, beginning of the week or actually beginning of the season I just really wanted just to progress my game individually, just dialing in the numbers, the accuracy, kind of everything all above. I think if you focus on that, the finishes will just kind of take care of itself.

Q. I guess going forward this sets you up pretty well, 20 cards on the line this year. What's your mindset going forward knowing you do have this win that will help you along as the season goes?

JUSTIN SUH: It will help a lot. I think overall just because there's 20 cards now, just kind of have to stay aggressive, you have to keep playing.

Yeah, I think overall it's just -- Korn Ferry, like it's hard to win out here but I think overall if you just keep working on your own game. I think that's kind of been my key just in my game in general, just focusing on what I need to focus on. Yeah, I'm excited to do that.

Q. Looking back in on this week, you had a 60 in round 3 and then really kept the scorecard clean the final two rounds. How were you able to do that for the most part and what was kind of working for you to keep it clean?

JUSTIN SUH: You know, this course is kind of, it kind of calls for that because it's very tough around the greens and they have these pin locations that are very elevated, kind of in little sections. Overall I played pretty conservatively. Even though I made a lot of birdies, I just gave myself chances on kind of the holes that presented themselves. So I think you have to be very precise with your irons and the numbers and with the wind and everything going on, that was definitely a tough task.

Q. Have you had to chance to talk to anyone since you won?

JUSTIN SUH: Just a few texts and there, but I think once I get back to the hotel room I'll start making some calls.

Q. When you think about the significance of winning here at an historic venue in Argentina at the Jockey Club which you have a chance of playing in 2019?

JUSTIN SUH: Yeah, I was playing with Cole today and I think he mentioned this was rated the No. 1 golf course in South America. I think to be able to play at such a prestigious course



with all the Korn Ferry guys and to come out on top, I don't know, just to have met everyone, the board members, everyone's extremely friendly and super grateful that we're down here and I think it's our job to present ourselves the best we can and appreciate the golf course itself.
