RASMUS HØJGAARD (-4)

Q. Rasmus, 4-under 66, a rollercoaster round, if we can get some comments on your play.

RASMUS HØJGAARD: Yeah, I think the good stuff today was very good but there was some -- there was some terrible shots out there as well, which was very costly. Yeah, I didn't -- to be fair, I didn't feel comfortable all day for some reason. Swing is still a bit on and off, which the score, you can see it in the score as well. But I'm happy to finish off with a par on 18 and post a good score.

Q. Did you -- I didn't see what happened, did you have to take a drop in the fairway on 18?

RASMUS HØJGAARD: Yeah. I hit it a bit offline on the right side and I had the grandstands in the way, so I had a free drop where I could move it a bit more left and have an angle to the green.

Q. About how far was that putt that you sank for par?

RASMUS HØJGAARD: It was probably 15 feet I'd say, 15 feet.

Q. When's the last time you shot 4 under when you had two doubles on the card?

RASMUS HØJGAARD: I can't remember, I can't remember. I wasn't -- to be fair, I wasn't thinking too much about it out there today. I was focused on trying to hit as many good shots as possible and see what I could get out of it. I think I managed to shoot a good score with the game I had today.

Q. You know, a guy like Viktor who's going through so many swing troubles, ends up winning like he does last week, you mentioned at times you were uncomfortable standing over the ball. How do you describe that feeling of having to still step up and hit the shot when you're not feeling 100 percent?

RASMUS HØJGAARD: I think it comes down to a lot of commitment at the moment. Certain shots out there suits my eye and some that are more tricky for me. There were a few shots I probably lacked a bit of commitment, and that's my only goal for tomorrow is just commit to every golf shot there is and then deal with whatever comes with that.
