

## Club Car Championship

### ROUND 1 INTERVIEW

April 3, 2025

### MYLES CREIGHTON

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**Q. Miles, bogey-free 6 under today, what was working well with your game to get around this course?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Played solid. I drove it OK. I had a couple loose ones but iron play was good, kind of played to the fat parts of the green. I got off to a good start and had a couple good looks early, which kind of gets you into the round especially teeing off at 7:20. Yeah, putted solid. This course is interesting in that a lot of times you feel like you have really good scoring opportunities and you miss a ridge and then you've got 30, 40 feet. So my pace was good putting and was able to get those down and make par. Took my opportunities when I had them.

**Q. Where is the trouble kind of around this course where you can kind of get tripped up out here?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** It's the wind. Like we were fortunate to I guess start on the back where holes I would have played into the wind, I guess it was going shorter anyway because it was the morning, but there wasn't much wind starting out. Just tricky. I said the spot on 8 tee is like the weirdest wind that we have all year. It's like on the tee it's into the wind but it's blowing 20 miles an hour straight down. It just makes no sense. There's a little bit of that stuff. Then yeah, around the greens if you short side yourself, it will be a long day. So just kind of playing the right way and getting off to a good start certainly helps you kind of hit it to the fatter side of the greens, take your chances when they come.

**Q. Last year being your first full season out here, what's been your comfort ability to start the season, getting to see most of these courses for a second time now?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Yeah, it helps a lot. I've kind of tried to make an effort, I probably overdid it I think a little bit last year with prep. Good prep over the time out at the course is kind of more important. I felt like I played -- my game's been in a good spot. It was pretty poor towards the end of last year, I was kind of struggling with things, but I felt better about my game this year than what my results have probably shown.

Yeah, just kind of -- it's really a mindset thing for me, just playing with confidence and keeping things simple, that kind of allows me to play good golf.

**Q. What's been an adjustment that you made to your preparation?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Yeah, I mean, I'm typically in the pro-ams, so that's nine holes. I'm kind of trying to come out a little bit later in the day and come out at like 3:00 or something on a Tuesday, not have to wait around and just kind of play and be able to go at your own pace on the course. To have nine holes like that to get comfortable with the course, and then just play the pro-am nine holes. I've seen the courses, my caddie does a good job, so I think just limiting the amount of time I spend at the course. I felt like it was hard to do that in South America just getting to the course, leaving the course, it all takes time. What should be like a three-hour day turns into like five or six. It's a little easier when you get back in the states to be able to have your own car and manage that and try to spend less time, work less hard.

**Q. You mentioned you feel like your game's been a little bit better than your results so far this year. I guess what do you think needs to kind of come together to have the results follow where you feel like your game is at?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Yeah, it's completely a mental thing with me, and it's easy on this tour. Guys say they get to the higher level and then they change what they do really well. I found myself certainly doing that. I didn't think I would be someone that would do that, but I certainly found myself doing that last year.

Do the things that I'm good at better and just yeah, keep things simple for me mentally. I tend to think a lot and keep just a couple simple feels that I've worked on at home and trust and just rely on those and not be quick to change when it's not exactly going my way.

**Q. What's kind of like one main thing maybe last year you thought you kind of tweaked a little bit more than you probably should have?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** I tried to get longer, I think. There's the right way to do that and the wrong way. I just was playing poor and instead of going back to what I do well, I was searching. It's funny, I did like a little junior clinic at home right before the Playoffs and I just kind of was teaching -- just going through good juniors in Nova Scotia kind of what I do when I practice. I kind of just realized I'm doing none of that anymore, so that was like a good eye opener for me to just kind of get back to doing that. Yeah, just trying to keep things as simple as possible for me.

**Q. A lot of times when you start teaching other people stuff you kind of learn something about yourself.**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Yeah, I'll even find myself doing it in the pro-am, giving the basic lesson of how not to slice it appeared it's just like I make it sound so simple when I explain it to other people. You know, as golfers you think a lot about it, it's very consuming thing that we do. Yeah, it's funny when you explain it to people, it's like it is that simple sometimes. It's a hard game, but the more you can simplify it, kind of the better, I think.

**Q. A little off topic question, have you been following the NCAA tournament much for basketball?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** Yeah, I followed it a bit. I wouldn't say I'm a big basketball fan. I went to a smaller school, so we made the tournament one year when I was there, maybe two. We were a 16 seed playing a 1 seed so not likely to have a chance. Yeah, I follow it a bit. I'd say it was probably like a pretty underwhelming tournament, not a ton of upsets and all the 1 seeds still alive. Yeah, I watch a ton of sports.

**Q. Do you do a bracket at all?**

**MYLES CREIGHTON:** I actually didn't. This is crazy, it's so bad of me. It's the first time I haven't done a bracket in probably 10 years. My dad does one and he tells me all about his, so I get updated with that constantly
