TREY WINSTEAD (-15)



Q. All right, Trey, our clubhouse leader right now. Just what was going well out there today?

TREY WINSTEAD: Most things. I mean, I felt like I hit the ball very nice, made quite a few good putts. Just had fun out there.

Q. A little bit of an up and down, I saw your scorecard, birdie, bogey, and then you had five in a row there. Just talk about that stretch.

TREY WINSTEAD: I mean, I three-putted I think the first three par 3s, so that was a little irritating. Just kind of knew I was playing well, just had to kind of get it in gear a little bit.

Q. And then this season you've been top-5 in three events going into the final round. Just kind of describe your mindset this week now.

TREY WINSTEAD: I mean, it's a really good course. Can also make a lot of birdies just kind of with the scores that have been posted today and the other days. Just keep the foot on the gas and know that only three rounds have been played, just keep rolling.

Q. Can you pull on any experience from those last couple of rounds?

TREY WINSTEAD: Yeah, I mean, just not make the final round bigger than it is. Like every shot matters the same whether it's the first round or the last round. Just keep going through the process.

Q. And then you've kind of been on the bubble of that top-20. Just explain how often it's in your mind and what the season's kind of looking like.

TREY WINSTEAD: Yeah, obviously especially now as the season goes on, that's what everyone's focus is going to be on, so just know that -- I mean, until someone's Tour Bound or they kind of get locked up, we're chasing every week to get as many points as we can. Just keep the foot on the gas.

Q. What did you learn last year from a being just outside the 30?

TREY WINSTEAD: I would say that was probably what I learned, is that I got off to a nice start to where I pretty much locked up keeping my card. So, your first year out here, like

that's the No. 1 thing you want to do at the start. So just now that kind of feeling like I learned from that, from last year is like OK, that's awesome, you have a job, place to play, great competition, but you want to get that promotion. So just keep the foot on the gas. You're kind of chasing points all year until the whole year, every tournament, every shot matters.

Q. We just talked about it but tell me who flew in today and how nice it is to have her support tomorrow.

TREY WINSTEAD: Yeah, my fiancée flew in this morning. I don't know, I'm better when she's around. She's made everything better. Just get to enjoy her presence.

Q. When are you guys getting married?

TREY WINSTEAD: December 20th.
