I hit a decent 3-wood on 17 and was fortunate to get up and down. Just I wish I was closer to Brian. He made two birdies coming in. You know, still got a chance.

Q. You'll be in that second-to-last group tomorrow. What's your mindset heading into tomorrow to try to hunt Brian and those leaders down?

KEITH MITCHELL: He's going to have to come backwards for us to catch him, especially tomorrow with the wind looking even stronger, it's going to be -- today played hard, tomorrow might even play harder. It's going to be a test and you're going to have to win with pars.
