**Q. Chris, nice playing today. How great did that feel?**

**CHRIS DiMARCO:** It's funny, when we started out the day -- my son actually qualified for his first Korn Ferry event in Kansas City, so my wife and I are kind of watching his front nine and he was right down to the wire, he was even par. I'm on 18, I've got about a six-footer for birdie after playing really good on the back, I think I birdied five or six holes on the back with a little eight-footer, my wife goes, "He made birdie to make the cut!" So obviously I was like pretty pumped.

Motivation, you know. Obviously so proud of my son and proud of myself today. I hung in there today. This is a good golf course, I hit the ball really well and I putted phenomenal. I think that's the key, when I'm putting good I feel like I'm very competitive out here. I've just got to keep the putter going, and 36 more holes. I think I made more birdies in the first two rounds this week than I have the whole year, I think I made 15 birdies in two days. I can promise you the last three tournaments combined I don't think I made 15 birdies. So something's good, is going right.

**Q. Do you think multitasking, having your mind on something else maybe helped you mentally at all?**

**CHRIS DiMARCO:** I did go back to my old irons, I went back to my i-210s. I hit my irons really solid, my distance control came back, I was able to kind of -- I hit a lot of -- most of my birdies were inside 10 feet. I made a couple long ones but most of them were the right distance. I think having that and feeling comfortable with that club back in my hand is a good feeling.

For the amount of rain that this course got, it's playing phenomenal. These greens are perfect. Greens even early in the week were not bad. They're rolling fantastic considering all the rain they had.
