BOO WEEKLEY (-12)

I've got my sister and her husband, kids came out. I've got a bunch of friends and family here. My mom and dad's here, my fiancée's here with her kids, my oldest boy's here. Unfortunately my other boy Tucker and Aiden ain't here with me, but I wish they was, but at the same time I know both of them's got to work so that's part of life.

Yeah, it's been very emotional. It's been a rollercoaster trying to get 'em all up moving, getting us all loaded in the vehicles. We've got like -- I mean Susan had like 12 of 'em in a car and I got like five in mine, we packed in there like a bunch of sardines.

Q. What would it mean to get this done tomorrow in front of everybody?

BOO WEEKLEY: Oh, it would be awesome. It would be really joyful. Like I said, the good Lord blessed me to do it. If it happens, it happens. If not, it's just a learning experience.
