**QUADE CUMMINS**

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**Q. Quade, bogey-free 8-under today. What was working well with your game to put up the good score this morning?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** Yeah, it was windy from the get-go. I gave myself angles going into greens. You have a lot of short clubs out here, especially when the wind is blowing this hard from the south. So I just took advantage early, made some good par putts early, and then hit it pretty well after four or five holes and putts were falling.

**Q. What's been the season like, first start on the Korn Ferry TOUR after getting your card last year and playing the PGA TOUR? What's been the adjustment for you?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** I mean, the biggest adjustment for me is you show up on Monday and you have no idea what's going on. You have to kind of learn the course. You have basically two days because I'm not in the pro-ams on Wednesday. Try to study like a test and take it from there and tee it up on Thursday.

**Q. You had mentioned this was your first career start, and you've played pretty solidly making cuts in your career. What's it like coming back?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** No, it's fun. I only live two hours from here, so I actually drove up Thursday morning, had an afternoon tee time yesterday. I have a buddy from home, he went to Wichita State, he's played here, qualified here lots of times. He said he normally plays it in a north wind so he doesn't get the benefit that we get with the south wind. We get the tougher driving holes all downwind, and you have to take advantage of them or you're going to get left behind with how many birdies people are making.

**Q. How different was the course today versus yesterday?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** It's definitely more of a challenge on the greens when it's this windy. You kind of get some of those sliders. It's always tough to make putts when the wind is at your back, especially shorter putts. You kind of feel like you lose a little bit of control with downhill, downwind putts, stuff like that. Luckily I didn't have a lot of challenging putts. I always was working back uphill, and I was putting -- I saw some go in early, so it kind of just flowed throughout the round.

**Q. What's the game plan heading into tomorrow?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** I'm just trying to hit greens out here. The greens are so good. They're very smooth. They're good making pace. They're not too fast, they're not too slow. In my mind, they're perfect speed, and hopefully we can keep the putter hot.
