**QUADE CUMMINS (-15)**

**Q. Quade, 2 under today, a little bit up and down start and then you got kind of rolling with just the bogey on 18 there. Kind of take us through your round today and what the course was like.**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** Yeah, I got off to a solid start, birdied 2 and 3 and then had kind of a mental mistake, hit it in the bunker on 4, just took too much club and actually made a really good bogey. I had to drop out of the hazard.

Made some more bogeys on the front nine but it wasn't -- like I wasn't hitting bad shots, it was almost like I was hitting too good of a shot, kind of went through the wind a little too much a few times.

And then just kind of took care of business on the back nine, made a couple good par putts. And then 18, missed the fairway, missed the green, missed an 8-footer for par, so it happens. 18's a really hard hole. I'm pretty pleased with 2 under, especially with how windy it was all day long. Hopefully we can get going tomorrow.

**Q. What's your mindset? Obviously mainly playing the PGA TOUR but you're still a competitor and in contention to win a golf tournament, so I guess where are you at heading into tomorrow?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** Yeah, I mean, it feels really good to be in contention. I haven't really been in contention in a while. You know, this is why we play. See what I have tomorrow and we'll go from there.

**Q. Kind of speaking of that, you've had success here out on the Korn Ferry Tour. It's going to be your first co-lead after 54 holes. I guess what's that knowing you're going to be in the last group tomorrow and people trying to chase you guys down?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** Yeah, I mean obviously seeing two 59s this week, nobody's safe. You know, the winner might be 25 under par, that's 10 shots off of what the lead is right now. You definitely have to keep the pedal down and make some birdies and see where that putts you after 18.

**Q. Are you kind of the type where you're not going to pay much attention out there or you're going to keep an eye on what other people might be doing?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** I don't know. I kind of looked around today and after -- you know, there was a leaderboard on 6 and I saw nobody got off to a crazy hot start.

We'll see. If I get off to a good start I probably won't pay much attention. I like looking around and knowing, you know. It kind of is reassuring when it's like OK, you need to go make some birdies so keep playing aggressive, but you need to play aggressive around here the entire round. We're trying to make a bunch of birdies tomorrow and see what happens.

**Q. With having success out here, getting your card last year, is there something to like just checking off maybe getting a win --**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** Yeah, I haven't won a pro event, I've been pro for four years, so it definitely would be nice to get a win. I think this week's been a success already. I came back from playing PGA TOUR to kind of see where my game's at and the game feels good. So hopefully I can build on this even if we don't win to finish out the PGA TOUR year.

**Q. What have you liked about your game this week?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** You know you have to make birdies out here and I've been able to do that. So I mean it's just kind of you know what you have to do and if you do it, great. If not, you need to go back and get better. So far, so good, and hopefully we can keep doing it.

**Q. What's the next 12 to 16 hours look like for you kind of in preparation for the last round?**

**QUADE CUMMINS:** I'm staying with a couple buddies and I've been talking about going to Texas Roadhouse, so hopefully we're going to go to Texas Roadhouse in about an hour or so. We'll go do that and probably go watch TV, but not a whole lot.
