**THOMAS ROSENMUELLER (-6)**

**Q. All right, Thomas, let's start with the end, 3, 3, 3 to finish. Talk us through that finish.**

**THOMAS ROSENMUELLER:** Yeah. I mean, the finishing stretch I felt like gave a couple opportunities with a par 5 if you hit a good drive, and then obviously semi drivable par 4 depending on whether or not you can avoid that tree.

Just got probably more aggressive than my caddie would have liked on the second shot into 7, I kind of overruled him in the fairway and hit it to probably about eight and a half feet and made the putt.

Then drove it just short right of the green on 8 and hit a beautiful little pitch shot in there. Just had to stay patient out there and in the end it finally came to me.

**Q. Currently T-2 on the leaderboard, you've got to like your position going into the weekend.**

**THOMAS ROSENMUELLER:** Yeah, absolutely. I feel like Chan's kind of separate himself a little bit, but this golf course can get you really quick, and you get a good round going, I think you're right in the mix again. Obviously T-2 is a bit of a new situation for me on the PGA TOUR, but I've been hitting the ball really well. And especially today I think I showed lot of determination of trying to stay up atop the leaderboard and trying to get it done.

**Q. Can you talk about the way the course played differently yesterday compared to today?**

**THOMAS ROSENMUELLER:** Yeah, it was already pretty tough yesterday, but I felt this afternoon it was a lot more little like purplish spots on the green. It was really hard to get to some of these flags and you just had to stay patient. I think the first 15 holes, I think 13 of them I'm trying to just make par. It was a pretty tough setup I'd say because the fairways are very tough to hit. They're really firm. So it depends, some of these slopey fairways, you've got to hit the right side of the fairway, but if you're barely in the rough it kind of hangs out there so you're aiming away from a lot of flags. It's the kind of golf that I enjoy, you cannot just blindly go at everything. Kind of have to think your way around the golf course and I think we've done a good job of managing that today.
