LUKE LIST (-7)



Q. Luke, how relieved are you to be able to finish up tonight?

LUKE LIST: Very. Yeah, it's nice to not have to come back in the morning, and I'll get a fresh start whenever we do tee off tomorrow.

Q. Do you think this gives you kind of any advantage going into this final round?

LUKE LIST: I don't know. I mean, it's pretty perfect conditions right now, so some guys, the leaders get to play in a little nicer conditions for longer holes. But it's late, it's a long day for everybody and they'll have an early morning. So I don't know what the weather's going to bring tomorrow, but I'm happy with the way I finished.

Q. Did you feel the course change at all?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, maybe a touch. I think the greens got a little moisture on them but they're still very firm. The course is spectacular, it's a really fun to play golf course especially this time of year with it being this firm.

Q. The punch-out, it wasn't a punch-out, the second shot on 18, to be able to get it on the green and just give you that birdie look, how big was that for you to finish it off?

LUKE LIST: Yeah, not a great drive, that's a tricky hole. It's hard to get in the fairway there. Guys have been kind of joking about it all week. Left was no good there, so I knew bailing right is probably a better miss off the tee, and it gave me a little alley to run it up, so that was nice.

Q. Lowest round of the tournament so far. What changed for you from round one to two to now?

LUKE LIST: I don't know, man, just playing solid. I mean I think I took advantage of the par 5s. There's only two of them, so birdieing those the last couple days helped. Just no bogeys the last two days so that's good around here. Just managing my game a little bit, hit a few more fairways. First I didn't drive it very well and that's really tricky out here if you miss fairways, so I drove it a little bit better the last two days.

Q. You mentioned 18 is a tricky hole, but talk about the course in general. You don't see too many low scores so far.

LUKE LIST: Yeah, the firmness is a big factor, right, and then we had some wind today



which obviously made it a little trickier, too. So you've really got to play position off the tee and figure out your angles. There's some greens that you just can't play at the pins, which is kind of fun. A lot of the tournaments we play this time of year in the summer, you're just firing at everything and trying to make as many birdies as you can, but this course is a little trickier and it's just kind of plodding along a little bit.

Q. The final hours leading up to tomorrow, what goes into that preparation and mentality to the final round?

LUKE LIST: Nothing but sleep right now.
