BOO WEEKLEY (-11)

Q. All right, Boo, first trip here to Endicott for the Dick's Open and an 8-under round today puts you in second place right now. How's it feel heading into tomorrow to put yourself back in contention?

BOO WEEKLEY: What now?

BOO WEEKLEY: Just get it airborne every chance I get, that's the whole goal, and get it in the hole as fast as you can go.

Q. Now, is there any -- like what goes through your mind when you have that break, that horn goes off? How do you stay kind of in your momentum there and finish up on 18?

BOO WEEKLEY: It kind of knocked it back. Like I just left that putt short in the jaws. If we could have finished up, I felt like I would have made it. I mean, I really did give or take, but I really felt like in my heart I would have made it. But you've got to wait 20 or 30 minutes and next thing you know, it's just -- it is what it is. It's golf, man.
