JASON CARON (-14)

Q. Your best finish this year, runnerup, just talk about the day.

JASON CARON: I played really solid today. I putted the ball awesome all week, speed was like very, very good, and made some good putts. I didn't drive it exceptionally well but my irons were pretty decent, too, so I can't complain there. I think mentally I played solid all week.

Q. Any big turning points in the round? Obviously Steve was kind of on a heater out there.

JASON CARON: Not really because he was making every -- not every putt, but he made a lot of putts and it was just hard to shoot 3 under on your opening nine holes and didn't gain a stroke. And then he started right in again on the back. So it was kind of difficult that way.

But you know what, you can only do what you can do and not worry about what they do. I just kind of kept telling myself that. Then second's not always too bad, either, especially in my situation. So I just tried to continue to click it along and next thing you know, we finish on 18 and it's over with.

Q. Feels like the narrative last year was like pinch me, right, what's happening with Jason Caron? Now you've come close to winning a few times, too. Are you starting to get past that like I'm ready to go win, not look at all these legends I'm around?

JASON CARON: Right, yeah, for sure. I mean, that's my ultimate goal starting the year was like, listen, I had a chance last year to win a couple, maybe I could win one this year, and now I've got two seconds. So it's there, it's just getting your week sometimes. Like Steve today, he played awesome. You just have to have those breaks and when they come your way, hopefully you're accepting and let it happen.

JASON CARON: Right.
