**PAUL PETERSON:** I don't know, struggled on the front nine. I mean, I hit it in that fairway bunker on 3 and couldn't get on the green, so I'll take that bogey.

Tough to three-putt there on 6, but in my defense I didn't hit that green all week, I don't think many people did, so it's tough to know how fast or slow that green was going to be from as far as I was.

Yeah, obviously would have loved to make that putt on 9. Yeah, it was great to battle back and make great putts on 14 and 16 there to give myself a shot, it was great. 9 under today is some really, really good golf. Congrats to William and Catman. Yeah, couldn't be happier for them.

**Q. And lastly, what positives do you take from this week moving forward?**

**PAUL PETERSON:** I mean, I can take all the positives. It's my best finish on Tour. A lot of good things from this week to build on. I've had a team of people who stuck with me and have worked really hard. Had a fill-in caddie this week, but Ben has been by my side really pushing me to get better. Wasn't in a very good spot in New Orleans and I've been working hard and I'm happy with that work and what I've been doing.
