JACKSON KOIVUN (-11)



Q. Jackson, thanks for stopping by, 68, 66, 65, you're continuing to get better and better with your scores this week. Talk a little bit about today's round.

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, today was just a long day with all the weather and going out and having to play eight holes in the morning. Just tried to keep fighting through it. The golf course is really good, it held up well with the weather and just looking forward to tomorrow.

Q. Yeah, talk a little bit about tomorrow. As of right now, seven back but you're going to be one of those guys in the last couple groups with a chance to make a run at it. What will be your mindset?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I mean, just go out there, make as many birdies as I can. This golf course can definitely punish you if you hit some bad shots, and playing smart when I can and aggressive when I can. It's definitely rewarding out here.

Q. The bogey on No. 12, if you can just take us through that.

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I was just a little uncommitted on the golf shot. Didn't leave myself in a bad spot, kind of just misjudged the chip. Not too upset with that. Still a 240-yard par 3 but definitely one I'd like to have back.

Q. What part of your game have you been most pleasantly surprised that it's holding up out here at PGA TOUR events and what part do you feel like I've got to still work on this some more?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Honestly, I think my driving has been pretty good these past couple weeks. I don't say I hit it overly far, but I've been hitting it pretty straight, which is very nice and been able to gain some shots that way.

And my ball-striking has been pretty good the past couple weeks, so happy with that, and I've always been a pretty strong putter, so that's kind of came over pretty well.

Definitely need to work on those wedges and that short game. Those guys are really good out here, they're like wizards with a wedge in their hand.

Q. And what made you want to play this event versus the Western Am this week?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I felt like this is a great opportunity. Western Am is an unbelievable event, I've played it a couple times. It was a very tough decision, but just being



close to home, it made sense for me.

Q. Did you have a goal this week in mind?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Not really. I try not to set too many goals for myself. Just come out here and have fun, see what I can do.
