**MATTI SCHMID (-8)**



**Q. First of all, the eagle on 17, could you walk us through that hole?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** Yeah, I had I think 124 meters, pulled it slightly but it came down to a perfect spot and went in luckily.

**Q. What's that feel like when a ball goes in like that from the fairway?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** I don't know. First thing I said, man it, that didn't happen to me for a while so it was some relief and a bit of, yeah, just excited.

**Q. When do you think's the last time you had a full shot hole-out in a tournament?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** Full shot, I think it was in Napa last year, so it's been a while.

**Q. And what was the turnaround like? What did you kind of do between the end of your second round and the beginning of your third round?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** Just sit in players' dining and wait around a little bit. Had a nice breakfast and then we went off again.

**Q. And how would you describe kind of yesterday? You were 1 under for the tournament with six holes to play and then made a couple birdies and the weather comes in. Did the cutline enter your mind at all at any point yesterday or this morning thinking about what that line might be?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** Yeah, absolutely, I think I came back to a close putt, which was obviously huge to make that, that made the way in a bit easier. Yeah, definitely on my mind, it had to be.

**Q. And how would you describe kind of what tomorrow kind of means to you in the season? Obviously not the end all be all in your career or anything, but what does tomorrow mean to you?**

**MATTI SCHMID:** Just go out there and try to do my best. It would mean a lot to get into the Playoffs, but I think I would have plenty more chances to do that, but it's a goal of mine to get through for sure.

**Q. You seem calm out there. Do you feel calm on the inside or do you sometimes feel some nerves?**



**MATTI SCHMID:** Depends on how things go I'd say. If they go sideways, not so much, but overall, decently calm.

**Q. Where do you think that comes from? Have you been like that your whole life or is it something you've consciously tried to --**

**MATTI SCHMID:** I think it's been similar like my whole life. Obviously I get nervous every now and then, but yeah, you have to be that way sometimes.
