STEWART CINK (-15, won 1st playoff hole)

Q. Stewart, it is so difficult to win on these tours, you've had -- since the Insuperity, you've been close as well. What got you to the finish line this week?

STEWART CINK: Honestly, I haven't had time to collect myself yet to know that. I know it wasn't tee balls. There was one really good tee ball today and it was on the 70 -- no, the 55th hole just now, but there wasn't a whole lot of other good ones.

My attitude was really good, it was probably the 15th club. Me and Chris both, we had a great attitude about being in the trees and hitting all kind of crazy shots and playing out of wrong fairways. It was an adventure, but that's golf sometimes. I was just pleased to make some really good putts down the stretch.

Q. You played from parts unknown on the 16th hole today. Tell us about that.

STEWART CINK: Well, I mean, I hit it right off the tee and the ball got way out there in jail. When I got to the ball, there was really no option to go left except straight sideways, but to the right down the seventh hole it looked like an option and it looked pretty good.

So Chris read my mind and he sprinted out there and got a yardage, and he did a great job giving us like a good zone to hit it into and it left me with a really comfortable lob wedge from another closely mown area where I got to lift, clean and place the ball, taking advantage of the rules.

No, we were all over the place a little bit and I didn't have my best off the tee, but I hit a lot of good shots when I needed to and I was really proud of myself, showed a lot of heart on the putting.
