Q. Great round of golf. Tell me about it.

RICO HOEY: Yeah, it was great. Conditions are awesome. It's pretty fast out here, rough's really thick. So it's kind of, you know, being three weeks off, you kind of just have to go out there and play well, and that's what I've been doing.

Q. Well, you made a big change during the last three weeks. Tell me about the long putter. Is it hard not to anchor it? How do you arrange that on your chest?

RICO HOEY: Honestly, it hasn't been too bad. Yeah, with the long putter I thought it would be kind of hard to adjust to, but it's like you just set up to it and it's kind of easy. Yeah, like I don't know, it's been kind of nice. My coach, Marcus Potter, and my caddie just sent it over during the off weeks and yeah, it's been great.

Q. Made more than 90 feet in putts here in the second round.

RICO HOEY: Yeah, that's unheard of for me. Yeah, it's nice to make some putts finally.

Q. Also made a putt just outside of 10 feet on the 18th hole. Tell me about that big eagle.

RICO HOEY: Yeah, that was nice. Yeah, I drove the ball down the middle and then hit a 7-wood onto whatever, 15 feet. Just nice easy right edge and made the putt.

Q. You know how it goes in all the events during the fall, you're just outside the top-100. What's your attitude and game plan going into all these events?

RICO HOEY: Honestly, just keep playing well, keep getting better. By the end of the day I'm still playing golf no matter where I'm going to be, whether it's here or anywhere else. You know, the biggest thing for me is just keep getting better in my game, so that's all I can do.

Q. You mentioned course conditions. I think the greens are beautiful. The rough is posing a problem. Are there any hole locations that will deserve our watching here as the course unfolds for the afternoon wave?

RICO HOEY: Yeah, I would say the ones that, what is it, 17, the par 3 because of the trees right there, and 16 as well because the tree's in the way. There's a few of them where the trees kind of sneak up on you.
