JACKSON KOIVUN (-15)

Q. What did you hit on 12?

JACKSON KOIVUN: 3-wood.

Q. What were you most pleased with about the way your day went?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Kind of just my bounce back. Didn't have a great start, not the start I was looking for, but was able to kind of turn it around midway through the round, make some birdies, make some putts, kind of flip the script and keep myself in contention.

Q. Was there a single shot -- I know you birdied 8, but was there a single shot after the two bogeys that allowed you to kind of get back in it?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Probably my bunker shot on 9. I hit that in fairway bunker, high lip, I was able to put it to about 18, 20 feet. That kind of told me I was definitely still in it.

Q. What are your thoughts about tomorrow?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Thoughts about tomorrow? I'm excited.

Q. You're in the last group and it's kind of a great chance.

JACKSON KOIVUN: I'm very excited, just looking forward to the opportunity.

Q. What do you think the best part of your game was today?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Best part of my game, probably either my putting or my mental game. I feel like I made a lot of good putts coming down the stretch that were just kind of bonuses. Honestly, the putt on 12 was big, putt on 14 was also pretty big, and just being able to not get too down on myself after not the greatest start.

Q. And you said you've played this course as a junior. How different is it now?

JACKSON KOIVUN: It's a little different. The routing was different when I played. It's a great finishing stretch now. It was very good back then, too, but it's just, you get the PGA TOUR come out here and keep the golf course going well, it's just a little dicier.

Q. Do you feel pretty comfortable now?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah. I felt very comfortable all day even after that start. Just again, like I said yesterday, it's just learning everything I can.

Q. What are you going to say to Russell after today?

JACKSON KOIVUN: I don't know how he played, but I might shoot him a little text and ask for some advice.

Q. How much do you think your experience Sunday at Wyndham is going to help you tomorrow?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, just kind of figuring out what I need to do, just lean on what I did back then and try to use that experience to go into the round tomorrow.

Q. You mentioned learning quite a bit last couple days, and it's all a good learning experience, but how do you balance the fact that it's learning and your confidence in going out and getting it done?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I think learning and confidence for me go hand in hand. The more I learn, the more confident I get. I think as I learn more, I'm just going to be more confident out here.

Q. The last amateur that won on Tour is Nick Dunlap. Have you talked to him at all just about golf, anything?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I know Nick pretty well. He's a great guy. I haven't really talked with him about this week, but definitely might want to go watch his rerun and see what he did.

Q. Did you win a national title as a freshman?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Our team did, yes.

Q. I know you wanted to come back for the right reasons, but what were those reasons, individual?

JACKSON KOIVUN: I do want to win an individual championship, that's something I still haven't checked off my list and I want to go chase that feeling again I had freshman year and try to go win the national championship.
