### DAVIS CHATFIELD (-12)

**Q. Well, we are here with the man of the hour, Davis Chatfield, and Davis, you had a long putt, probably about 30 feet on the last hole and you were not leaving that short, as you just told me. Tell me what you felt over that last putt.**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, I've never had a chance at a 59, and honestly through like 13 or 14 holes today I wasn't thinking about it either. So yeah, when I was standing over that putt I felt good. I had a good read. Chandler was next to me and had a good read on it when he hit first, and yeah, I just hit a great putt and lucky that one went in.

**Q. Well, you came off a birdie at 14 and then you made an albatross at 15. What did that feel like and what were your thoughts as you were standing over that shot?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, to be honest, like it wasn't even a great 3-wood into that hole. I had 268 and kind of like knife pulled one and was lucky to clear that bunker, and then it just chased up and heard people screaming on the green. Made a nice 2.

**Q. Once that shot fell, picking up 3 on a single hole, did 59 cross your mind at any time during your round?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** I knew I had a chance. I still needed to birdie 16 obviously. That was a very gettable hole, so when I got up and down there I knew I just needed one on the last two, and yeah, came down to the last putt. Fortunate.

**Q. Well, you're part of history, congratulations, 59, off to a good start here in the first round. Good luck the rest of the week.**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Thanks so much, appreciate it.

**Q. Davis, 59 for you today, made the turn at 4 under. I guess take us through that back nine where you made the albatross.**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, started off nice birdieing 10 and 12. Had a look on 13, didn't go in but I was really comfortable all day with just how I was hitting the ball and I knew the putts would fall eventually. It was nice to get one on 14, and then making a 2 on 15 was crazy. After that I figured I had a chance at a 59 and yeah, just fortunate with how those last three went.

**Q. Can you walk us through the 2 on 15?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah. I hit a good drive and I had 268 yards in. Was honestly thinking about laying up, playing it as a three-shotter. Didn't hit a great 3-wood, to be honest. I like knife pulled one over the bunker and it trundled up there and everyone started screaming and yeah, wasn't expecting that obviously.

**Q. And have you had a 59 before?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** No, first one.

**Q. And what was your thought on the last knowing you had the putt there on the last on 18?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Wasn't going to leave it short. Yeah, I got a good read, Chandler hit before me, he was right next to me. I knew the read, I just had to execute and was fortunate.

**Q. Your thoughts on this course this week so far?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** It's a crazy golf course. It's a lot of fun to play, a lot of (indiscernible) obviously but I love it. I think it's a cool layout, it's different than what we usually play. Yeah, it's a good changeup.

**Q. So is there a chance, because you were live on Golf Channel when it happened, you do it in very dramatic fashion there at the end, is there a chance this changes the trajectory to some extent of your career?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Maybe, I don't know. Only time will tell I guess.

**Q. I'm talking about big picture, sponsorships.**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, I hope so. That's always the goal to get as many big sponsorships I guess as possible. Yeah, fortunate with the ones that I have and moving forward.

**Q. When you played your practice rounds out here, did you sense that you would be stepping on the gas all week?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, I figured yes. It's not like breezy out here, there's a bunch of birdie holes. I'd say there's three or four tough par 4s and once you get by those, yeah, you can really birdie any of them to be honest. It's fun. Course is in great shape and looking forward to the next few rounds.

**Q. Have you had a chance to look at your phone yet?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Yeah, there's a lot of messages. Yeah, I have to go through these now.

**Q. What's your personal lifetime best? In a true competition round, what had been your best score?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** Nine under earlier this year in Abaco and I did it in Chicago.

**Q. Par 70?**

**DAVIS CHATFIELD:** I think Chicago's a 71 maybe. Might be wrong, yeah.
