BLADES BROWN (-16)

Q. Blades, 11 under today, I guess just take us through that start on your front nine, really got you off to a good day.

BLADES BROWN: That was a lot of fun. I haven't gone, I think what was it, 7 under in seven holes too often in tournaments and for it to be here at the Patriot Golf Club is really special.

Q. Seeing all the low scores out here, even the 59 yesterday, I guess when you made the turn, did you maybe start thinking about 59 being a possibility?

BLADES BROWN: Well, so I actually set two personal bests today. I don't think I ever shot 7 under on nine holes, and then I shot 11 under today, which that's my personal best. I shot 10 a couple of times, but I was actually, I was thinking on the first tee I was like dang, par 3 hole No. 9, if this goes in it's 59.

I mean, I'm super happy with the 60, which by the way that was really surprising to see how low the scores are. This is not an easy golf course. I just think you put professionals on a course with no wind, I mean, get ready for the birdies. Yeah, I'm really pleased with the way I played today.

Q. On the front nine too you made an eagle and you almost made it for an albatross. From the fairway did you think it might be going in?

BLADES BROWN: Well, I'm going to be honest, I didn't execute the shot exactly how I wanted to there and I kind of got lucky with the contour of the green. Then I held the finish and I was like wait, wait, nope. Then it got up there and it was two inches from the hole. Yeah, tapped it in and made an eagle.

Q. Coming into this week, started inside the top 75, but now you're at least going to make the cut and put up a solid showing. What was your mindset coming into this week and what you're trying to accomplish?

BLADES BROWN: Yeah, I was very aware of where I stood on the points list, I think I was 73rd or 72nd. Rather than I guess running from that pressure, I just embraced it. I said whether I do how I wanted to today or this weekend or I don't do how I wanted to, I'm still going to be the same person. I said to myself I'm going to embrace it, I'm going to have a lot of fun and try to execute the shots that I can.

Q. What have you been most proud of in your game this year and playing the majority out on the Korn Ferry Tour and getting your first experience out here?

BLADES BROWN: I would say I think the Korn Ferry Tour for me has been life changing because it has taught me to go low, it's taught me some of the systems that I need to have in place once I get to the PGA TOUR because if I didn't have the systems or I didn't get to the Korn Ferry Tour, definitely not have those systems in place. Korn Ferry has put me in position to get better not only as a player but as a person as well.

Q. Would you take this position that you're currently in at the start of the year?

BLADES BROWN: Absolutely, 100 percent, yeah. You're telling me I get to play on the Korn Ferry Tour? Let's go, I'm in.

Q. And what do you think going into this weekend knowing low scores are out there to potentially win or just be in contention on the weekend?

BLADES BROWN: I mean, one of the things I love to do, I love to compete and right now I'm doing just that and having a lot of fun. I've got an awesome team around me. My dad has played such a pivotal role in my career, and especially last week with the week off, or actually I missed the cut at Scarlet and took the week off. My dad said we're going to figure out this driver thing. Luckily, we were starting to hit some fairways and I think that's been the game changer this week. My dad just kind of helping me out and yeah, got things situated.

Q. What do you guys think you found with the driver?

BLADES BROWN: I mean, golf is so much easier, it's so much more fun from the fairway. He's kind of helped me out in some of the situations and yeah, now we're starting to hit driver just how we want to.
