CHAD CAMPBELL (-5)

Q. Chad, looks like since Endicott, you had a good week there and struggled just a little bit. Anything in particular going on?

CHAD CAMPBELL: You know, I feel like I've been playing all right, I just haven't really gotten any results out of the work I've been doing. Today finally paid off, made some putts.

Q. Do you like this kind of course?

CHAD CAMPBELL: I do, yeah, it's great. It's pretty windy out there, definitely some tough shots.

Q. What was clicking today? No bogeys, which is pretty good in the wind and everything out here. You've got to leave it in the right places on the greens.

CHAD CAMPBELL: Right.

Q. Was there anything in particular you were doing well?

CHAD CAMPBELL: I putted pretty well. You always have to shoot 5 under it seems like. I drove it pretty good. I had one bad drive but other than that, kept it in play, tried to make it as easy as possible.

Q. Any long birdies?

CHAD CAMPBELL: I made a good one on 8, it was probably 25 feet on 8.

Q. And second year on Champions Tour, how are you finding the competition? Is it tougher than you thought it was going to be, or were you fully prepared to come out here --

CHAD CAMPBELL: No, I was pretty prepared. I was warned that you don't just show up out here and start beating up on everybody. I was pretty warned. Competition's great. Everybody can still play and everybody works pretty hard at it still.

Q. You played on a couple of Ryder Cup teams. What did you think of this most recent one?

CHAD CAMPBELL: Well, I thought Sunday was great. We made a good comeback there on Sunday. I wish it would have been a little bit better but I was glad to see 'em play better



on Sunday and have a chance. The first two days were a little rough for us, but we fought back.

Q. I don't think you played Bethpage, did you?

CHAD CAMPBELL: No, ma'am. Oh, I have played it, yes.

Q. OK. What did you think of the course? Was it suitable for that kind of a competition?

CHAD CAMPBELL: It played totally different than it did -- I played, I don't know, I think it was a U.S. Open there and then I played a FedEx cup event there so it was -- the greens were hard and fast and the rough was nasty. It was totally different than the setup that they had last week.

Q. Chad, you had 20 starts this year and looks like you played a lot. Was that your intention, to come here and play as much as you could?

CHAD CAMPBELL: Yeah. Basically kind of had the last four years off, from 46 to 50. Had an injury and had surgery. Nothing too bad but didn't play too much during that time. Only played 10, 12 tournaments in the last four years. It's nice to get back and play a normal schedule.

Q. Is it the competitive juices or is it just what you do, you play golf and you just want to wake up in the morning and --

CHAD CAMPBELL: No, it's the competition. I'd say the majority of guys out here, we love competing against each other. A lot of us are good friends but we definitely love beating each other.

Q. (inaudible) competitive juices going?

CHAD CAMPBELL: No. I've got four boys, they compete amongst themselves. They're getting into golf so it's kind of fun watching them play and try to outdrive me and stuff like that. They're getting pretty close.

Q. They haven't beat you on the golf course yet?

CHAD CAMPBELL: They haven't beat me yet.

Q. What other sports are they into?

CHAD CAMPBELL: Growing up they played everything, baseball, football, basketball. Really just started getting into golf the last two years. My youngest is 11 so he's still playing a little bit of everything, playing golf as well. We'll see what he ends up.



Q. How old is your oldest?

CHAD CAMPBELL: He's a senior.
