**ALEX CEJKA (-8)**

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**Q. For a guy at 7:00 a.m. that told me there's no birdies out there, you sure made a ton of 'em.**

**ALEX CEJKA:** Yeah, it was, I want to say I guess, a lucky day. I hit a lot of good shots, but you've still got to make the birdies. I drove it well. It's a little bit easier on this golf course out of that rough in those conditions to hit it from the fairway, so I really drove it well. I hit some bombs, and in the middle of the fairway, so that obviously helps. I missed a couple greens but made great up-and-downs so that kept the momentum going a little bit.

I'm just happy with the way I've been playing not the last two days but even in the last couple tournaments. The score maybe didn't show it, but I'm playing well, I have a good vibe going and hopefully I can continue for a couple more rounds or maybe a couple more tournaments till the end of the season.

**Q. With the weather coming tomorrow, how does that figure into your plan going into tomorrow?**

**ALEX CEJKA:** Plans, I don't know. When I wake up I'm going to assess the situation. Right now, yes, the weather's coming. We'll see how bad it is, how much rain or how cold or how much wind and then we'll adapt in the morning.

I'm from Europe, I'm used to playing in bad weather. I don't like it, I guess nobody likes it, but we played maybe a little bit more often in bad conditions let's say this way.

But you've still got to go out there. You know, this course is tricky when it's raining and probably 20-mile-an-hour winds with those greens, it's going to be a challenge.

**Q. Speaking of those greens, are they close to being unplayable?**

**ALEX CEJKA:** No. They're really fast. Unplayable I wouldn't say, but they're really fast. If you miss it on the wrong side, then you really have no chance, especially when you're chipping or have bunker shots. When you have putts, you can get it semi close, but when you miss it in the wrong spot, you always have a weird lie here in that bermudagrass, it's really tough.

**Q. What would a win mean for you tomorrow?**

**ALEX CEJKA:** I think every win is great. Let's don't jump the gun. It would be awesome. I've been so many times in that position where I was like tied for the lead, just playing the



last group, but we've got to grind. If we play 18 more holes if the weather is good, we've got to grind and play 18 more holes and then we'll see what happens.

**Q. Looks like Mr. Langer will be in the final group with you. How nice will that be?**

**ALEX CEJKA:** It's great. I think we played here a couple times together already in the last round. Maybe not final group but maybe second or third last group. It's always great to play with Bernhard, but of course you want to kick his ass when you play with him. He's a great friend, he's loved all over the world not only in the golfing scene but everywhere, so it's going to be great, I'm looking forward to it.
