JOSH DUANGMANEE: Yeah, I hit the tee shot on 15, hit the pin, kicked off the green. He made birdie. Then I was 1-up going into 16. Had a good break on 16 hitting the lip of the bunker, kicking back out in the fairway. Just had to kind of just hit fairways and greens. It's easier said than done, but that's all it takes out here.

Q. This is kind of the capstone event for the fall. Regardless of the result, how do you feel this sets up your team for this spring?

JOSH DUANGMANEE: I think we're in a good space being No. 1 in the country, that's pressure and a privilege. If we keep our head in the right space, then we'll be set for spring.
