No, I mean, I got off to a great start honestly making some birdies. I feel like I've done that a lot in final rounds recently when I've had a chance to win, so that was nice. Fortunately, the putter heated up, made a lot of putts on the back nine. Yeah, it was fun feeling the nerves down the stretch trying to hold things off. It was nice to make a couple down the stretch.
