**RICO HOEY ( -10)**



**Q. Rico, career best 62 for you today. Just what are some of the highlights in your round there?**

**RICO HOEY:** Made an eagle. Hit all 18 greens, that's a first for me. I thought I missed the green on the last with a chip shot, but stayed on and I was happy with that. Played well. I kept the ball in play and just gave myself a lot of opportunities.

**Q. What were the -- since we don't get Shotlink on Plantation, 14, how did you get the eagle?**

**RICO HOEY:** Hit the fairway, then I hit a 4-iron from I think 250, left myself 45 feet and made the eagle.

**Q. Any other long putts in there?**

**RICO HOEY:** Made had a 35-footer, a 24-footer.

**Q. Where was that 35-footer?**

**RICO HOEY:** The par 3, the front nine. Yeah, the front nine, 3, made a 33-footer there. Made a 24-footer somewhere, I know I did. I can't remember.

**Q. Seven 3s on the back. Have you ever had a card like that?**

**RICO HOEY:** I don't know. I was just trying to make as many birdies as I could. I'm sure I have maybe on a par 3 course.

**Q. Obviously the weather being what it is today, the course condition and the way the weather looks like it's going to be the rest of the week, is it going to take every birdie that you can get to keep up with these guys? Do you think it's going to be pretty competitive all the way through?**

**RICO HOEY:** I mean, yeah, we're on the PGA TOUR, everyone's really good out here. So you've got to go out there and just keep playing great golf. That's all that matters, right?

**Q. And Davis talked about he showed some patience today and everything. I wondered, given the fact that a lot of guys are going to be making a lot of birdies, where's the line between being patient and being aggressive?**

**RICO HOEY:** It's just, yeah, I think that's -- everyone has different answers. For me, it's all you can do is hit the best shot that you can and you take the opportunities you can. Take care of the par 5s and that's all you can do.

**Q. If you had to give yourself a grade for this season, you played a lot of golf, what -- what's your priority in the offseason? What are you going to work on?**

**RICO HOEY:** Honestly, nothing. Probably hang up the clubs for a bit, go relax, go have a good time. Honestly, probably just keep working on the things I'm doing right now and hopefully it keeps paying off.
