Q. Is that something you can handle like actively thinking about the swing while you're out on the golf course playing competitive rounds or are you doing that at this point or do you kind of trust the prep?

WYNDHAM CLARK: Yeah, like right now I just have one swing thought when I play. Like when I'm on the range I'm thinking of a couple things that I want to do and then while I'm playing I'm just thinking about the heel leading the toe coming in so I have an open face. It's just one simple thought and that's what I'm going with.

Q. Looking back on this past season, if you could give it a letter grade, what would it be and why?

WYNDHAM CLARK: An F that became an F-plus. It just was a bad year. A lot of crap happened and then I kind of salvaged it at the end. But the good thing is we've got next year and we're almost done. So yeah, I'm looking forward to next year.
