Q. Scottie, how would you -- how would you kind of assess your play today?

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: Yeah, did a lot of things.

Q. Can you expound on the lot of good things? What worked best for you today, let's say that?

Q. The 16th hole, does that not fit your eye kind of -- I know you hit a drive in the fairway today, but does it not fit your eye as well as maybe some of the other holes?

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: I hit the drive in the fairway today and I basically didn't have a stance, so you explain that one to me. That's not really on me, it's just poor luck, which I think happens in the game of golf.

Q. Even like the drives the first two days just did not fit your eye the best or was it just bad swings?

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: So you're asking me about two drives I've hit in the last three days?

Q. Yeah.

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: Next question. That's ridiculous.

Q. What do you feel like you -- anything you feel like you need to tighten up for tomorrow to come out on top?

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: Just continue to execute. Like I said, did a lot of good stuff today and more of that tomorrow, I think I'll be in a good spot.



Q. The 18th hole has been challenging for everyone this week. How do you overcome that?

SCOTTIE SCHEFFLER: I mean, it's a hard second shot. I think with the wind direction today it gets a bit easier. But yeah, it's like you've got the water left coming in, water left off the tee and anything right of the green, that's probably one of the most difficult up-and-downs on the course, so pretty challenging hole.
