JACOB BRIDGEMAN (-18)



Q. Jacob, I know you've dreamt of winning on the PGA TOUR since you were a little kid, but to do it on this golf course against this field and have Tiger Woods be the host to hand you the trophy, is this how you dreamt it up?

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: This is way, way better than I've ever dreamt it.

I thought it was going to be a lot easier than that. It was honestly easy until I got to about 16 and then it got really hard. Yeah, I can't believe it. I made it about as hard as I could have made it I think at the end, making it one shot and having to make a three-footer, yeah, this is incredible.

Q. You made it look easy for a really long time and all week we have been so impressed with how steady you are. In fact, Chris Gotterup texted me and said you're as steady as they come. Take me into those moments of this final stretch, what you were feeling and how you were able to handle it.

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: I didn't really feel really crazy nervous until I had a five-footer for bogey on 16; that one was sketchy. I hit a really good putt and luckily it went in, and then I was really nervous from there on out. I couldn't even feel my hands on the last couple greens, I just hit the putt hoping it would get somewhere near the hole, and both of them I left a mile short, but I'm glad it's done now.

Q. You were just taking a look around before they came down to us and you said "Whoa." These fans have been amazing. It's obviously really special to be back here in Los Angeles. Talk about what these fans have done, what this golf course means as you are now their champion in 2026?

JACOB BRIDGEMAN: Yeah, this is -- winning at this course in front of so many people is a dream come true. This is a golf course that I grew up watching on TV, watching guys win. Everyone was great today, everyone was yelling for me, pulling for me. I felt super supported all day, it was amazing.
