GORDON SARGENT (-11)

Q. Gordon, great playing this week. What was it like being in contention through the weekend and what did you gain from that?

GORDON SARGENT: Yeah, it was good. Definitely first time in a PGA TOUR event so kind of tried to lean on experiences in the past in college golf and amateur golf, stuff like that. Yeah, it's definitely different. I think it's easy to get ahead of yourself a little bit and think about kind of the results, so tried to kind of just stay present and yeah, definitely going to take a lot away from this week.

Q. Did this feel like the most complete performance you've put together since turning pro?

GORDON SARGENT: For sure, yeah. I think it's the best I played. I played really well the first day, kind of got everything out of my game I feel like, and then last couple days was a little bit more of a grind. Didn't necessarily -- I played better than I scored. Yeah, the putter kind of wasn't as hot as it was the first day, but it was nice to kind of keep giving myself opportunities and kind of hang in there a little bit.

Q. And describe what the learning curve has been like since you finished up your college career to now.

GORDON SARGENT: Yeah, a lot on the golf side but also just off the course, just kind of figuring out how you want to go about your business. Playing a lot of weeks in a row, trying to figure out how you can stay healthy and energized and stuff, and being excited to go out there.

So I think, yeah, golf-wise, just trying to get better each week, and then off the course, kind of figure out what works. Obviously like when I show up at some events I don't even know where the locker room is and stuff like that. So I think just getting comfortable and yeah, taking it day by day, not getting too far ahead of myself.
