JUSTIN SUBER (-10)

Q. Bogey-free 63 tying your career low here on Tour. What did you like about your second round?

JUSTIN SUBER: Yeah, everything was clicking for me. Hit a bad shot on 12 and made a chip-in from a nice spot. Kind of got it rolling from there. Just kind of felt easy after that, just balls in the right spots, and made a couple putts.

Q. Any birdies or shots stand out on the day in particular?

JUSTIN SUBER: I mean, that one on 12 felt good. I hit a mini driver off the tee on 16 and laid up and made a birdie there. Was going for it yesterday, but my caddie, Greyson, and I decided that pin wasn't great to go for it. So that felt really good to convert a birdie that way.

Q. Somewhat a similar position from last year at this tournament heading into the weekend. What suits you about this course?

JUSTIN SUBER: Yeah, I really like this course. It's really cool what the Astros have done with this event. The overseed is really cool. It's an awesome course. I like that it's long, and I think it suits my iron game pretty well.

Q. Following Valspar, decided to come here and Monday qualify. Kind of walk us through that timeline of when you decided and then from teeing it up yesterday.

JUSTIN SUBER: Yeah, it's kind of weird because I was last man in on Tuesday at Valspar for this week, and then I think there's like 12 or 10 commitments within 24 hours and I just like kind of went from thinking I was going to be definitely in to, I mean, not even close.

So went on Saturday night, came here, played a practice round at Westwood on Sunday. Then played the Monday, I Mondayed in. Didn't play as well as Sam so I had to hang around all day. But luckily, it was good enough to get in the event.

Q. And following your rookie season, how nice is it that you've seen a lot of these courses the second time versus trying to get all 18 holes in your practice round?

JUSTIN SUBER: Yeah, I only played nine on Tuesday and then walked the other side, just kind of hit some chips and putts. That definitely helps. To be a little behind the 8-ball normally Monday qualifying in, but it was kind of nice to get that extra round of competition and then just play nine Tuesday, rest Wednesday, and practice a little bit.



Q. Finally, who do you have on the bag with you this week?

JUSTIN SUBER: Greyson Porter. He's been caddying for me since Detroit. I know him from home. Played college golf at Florida State, and we kind of played a bunch of junior golf together. Been lucky to have him help me out.
