BRONSON BURGOON (-8)

Q. Hey, Bronson, where are you based at now?

BRONSON BURGOON: The Woodlands.

Q. You're still at The Woodlands?

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah.

Q. OK. Just talk about the fact that you got a sponsor exemption and you're taking advantage of it.

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah, it's good. Home event's always nice, sleep in my own bed. A little bit of a drive, but it's still nice. Yeah, I was very grateful for the exemption. Yeah, Brian White, I was super, super excited when he called me and said that he was giving me a spot.

Q. Yeah. Well, you played well three days. Just talk about how well you've been playing.

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah, I've been playing nice. Yeah, it's weird, 38, I feel like a rookie to be honest with you. Body's healthy. Started getting good, I don't know, probably October, September of last year I started feeling like I can do this. You know, my whole career's been plagued with me having to manipulate something, my body, my shoulder in particular. Just made everything really difficult. Now I feel like I can actually play a little golf.

Q. Yeah. You birdied the first three holes, correct?

BRONSON BURGOON: Yes, sir.

Q. Talk about those birdies.

BRONSON BURGOON: Obviously it was a great start. I got lucky on 1. Hit a good drive, and then we kind of got the wrong -- the wind wrong and I had like 50 feet and knocked it down. I mean, that doesn't happen every day. But then solid birdies on 2 and 3. All pars until 15, then the rest pars. It was clean.

Q. Very clean.

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah, yeah.



Q. Yeah. Going into tomorrow, you've got to be feeling pretty good about your game, pretty healthy. Shoulder's OK and everything?

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah, I'm good, yeah. I'm excited. I'm enjoying golf for the first time in a decade and a half, two decades. I feel very grateful to be out there playing, honestly, and just having fun.

Q. I'm glad to hear that because you won a state championship at The Woodlands, right, in high school?

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah. That was about the last time I was healthy.

Q. Then you hit the key shot that won the National Championship in college at A&M?

BRONSON BURGOON: Yeah. My golf in college was very subpar. I was struggling with my shoulder then. I didn't know what it was, and I wish I would have got it operated on back in 2006. It's been a long time.
