NICOLAI HØJGAARD (-17)

Q. Great playing. Just kind of talk us through your day.

NICOLAI HØJGAARD: Yeah, another great day on the golf course. Felt pretty similar to yesterday. Might even be slightly better like the feeling I had on the golf course today. Very pleased with how I slowly built up the round.

Q. You and Gary both started with a bogey on 1 there. Kind of talk us through that sequence and how you were able to rebound.

NICOLAI HØJGAARD: Yeah, it was a little awkward, all of us hit it a little bit right of the tee off 1. I caught a flyer for the first time really this week and I missed just my chip shot, made a 5 out of -- didn't really hit a good shot on the hole. All good rounds start with a bogey. After that, refocused.

Q. Anything about the course conditions that led to your success today?

NICOLAI HØJGAARD: The course is playing into my strengths. Good driving length off the tee and approach play, and then I felt like I had good pace with the putter all day. It felt one of those rounds where I felt I didn't do much ended up shooting a good score.

Q. What would it be like to get it done with a win tomorrow?

NICOLAI HØJGAARD: It would mean a lot. That's what we play for. 18 holes, there's still a lot of players in the field that can win the tournament, but obviously we have, or Gary and I have a good chance tomorrow. I'm going to go out, try to build up the round like I did today, try to see where we end up. I'm happy where the game is at.

Q. Is there something that you draw back on when you're in positions like this with a chance to win that could help you tomorrow?

NICOLAI HØJGAARD: Yeah, I've never got it done over here yet, but yeah, you always -- you know it's going to be a grind, you know it's going to come down to potentially the last few holes anyway tomorrow. So you've just got to stay in the fight and play your best and do your best and then let's see where we end up.
