FREDDIE JACOBSON (-12)

Q. Freddie, 66, 12 under total after two rounds here at the Hoag Classic. Some comments on your round today?

FREDDIE JACOBSON: Yeah, it was a little bit inconsistent early on. I thought it was either kind of pretty good or I was a little bit off. Kind of had to work my way into the round a little bit. Kind of got it going towards the end of the front nine a bit and played pretty steady on the back nine. Balls just didn't quite drop on the back. Felt like I was hitting good putts. Happy about the day.

Q. What is it about this place you like? You played very well here last year.

FREDDIE JACOBSON: Well, I don't know. It's hard to say. I didn't feel very good coming into the week. I played so and so for a couple of weeks coming into, even in the pro-am the day before.

I felt like yesterday I struck the ball really well, felt good like I was back playing a similar way I was in Hawaii. So I was kind of happy after the pro-am with the practice sessions. And short game felt better. Swing started to feel a bit more consistent. Didn't feel quite as good today, not warming up, not on the course. Still OK, but it was nice to at least for a day or so get back to where you're really controlling your golf ball well. Going to keep working to try to get closer to that.

Q. (Question about range session.)

FREDDIE JACOBSON: Well, I've got to give it 10, 15 minutes at least, see if we can find a little bit better there. There was a couple of, like I tried to hit a cut in there at the last with the 4-iron, like when you don't quite come out of the middle of the face. Yeah, a little session, not too much though.

Q. You talked a little bit about the golf course. As far as the conditions of the golf course, how's the golf course playing this week?

FREDDIE JACOBSON: Yeah, it's in great shape. I like it. I think you pick and choose where to be aggressive. You can play this course really aggressive and I like that. You can also kind of play back a little bit. Like on 9 I hit a 4-iron today. I always hit driver there, but I just wanted to -- hadn't hit that many fairways and I just wanted to put it in play. You can still play it from there. I like that it gives options. And it's in pristine condition. Nothing wrong with the weather, either.



Q. So you played well last year. You're playing well this year. You must like it here.

FREDDIE JACOBSON: I do, I do. I mean, I love the course and I also love the area. It's beautiful. Tried to swing down by the ocean, we might be looking at hopefully some surfing on Monday. Try to sneak that in. Yeah, we like the whole area.
