MIN WOO LEE (-12)

Q. Great round today. Take us through your day.

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah, it was -- I guess the result was not too bad and where I finished kind of on the leaderboard wasn't terrible. It felt very uncomfortable. Didn't feel like I had my good game all day, but I think it was just one of those days. The greens are getting more baked and you just can't get as comfortable as you want to. It's getting a little bit firmer. It's playing a little bit different. So I think our group, we were plodding along, but none of us got anything going, unlike the two leaders.

Q. What felt so uncomfortable for you today?

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah, just a little different conditions. The pins were in pretty tricky spots. Yeah, it's just a course where it played pretty long today, too. Complete different wind as well. We went from like a south wind to a north wind, so all the par 5s played into the wind, knockdown wind. Yeah, played a little tricky. I would start with there and then yeah, the greens just got baked. Like for me, comfortability on the greens were not very high with the confidence. I'll go sort it out afterwards.

Q. Can you talk us through that shot from your knees?

MIN WOO LEE: It wasn't the most pleasing lie when I first got there. It was nearly very unplayable because it was on such a steep hill. Lucky I'm somewhat flexible and I can get low and, yeah, you know, play that shot. Came out as good as I wanted it to and yeah, it was a nice shot.

Q. Do you have fun playing shots like that, being creative?

MIN WOO LEE: It's nearly I wouldn't say easier, but the decision becomes easier because you only have one shot. That was the only shot I could hit. Yeah, I'm not going to talk myself down, it was a very hard shot, but just the decision making. I feel like out here when you're chipping around the greens, you've got options and that makes it a little bit tricky especially with the lies being good and it not coming out as good as the lie looked. Yeah, I mean, I'll pat myself on the back for that one.

Q. How does your game feel right now compared to last year?

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah, it feels good. I mean, obviously played really good over the weekend last year. Yeah, I feel like I'm not playing as solid, but I'm still around there. That's the thing that I wanted to get better at. I think the best players in the world do that really good, they



don't have their A game, but they somehow make a score. I still have bad rounds, but this year's been really good.

Q. With being as far back as you are going into the final round, is there something to focus on tomorrow? Do you set a number and just try to see if that number gets you close or closer to the leaders?

MIN WOO LEE: Yeah, just got to stick to the process and hopefully make a lot of birdies. You'll probably need help from them to come backwards. I think I'm in the final group, so I'll have a nice show tomorrow. Yeah, I think you just go out there and get off to a hot start and see what happens.

Q. Who were you playing rock, paper, scissors with?
