Q. You mentioned the team behind you, we saw your wife Gaby, she walked every step of the way with you today, she just gave you a huge hug on 18. Your kids are at home watching on TV. What do you want to say to your family?

GARY WOODLAND: Thank you. I wouldn't be anywhere before this without them, there's no chance I could do this without Gaby, for sure. This has been hard on me, this has been a lot harder on her and I love her to death.

Q. That team includes, we just saw you embrace Mark from excel, Randy Smith, part of your coaching staff. How confident do you feel in your golf game right now as you now look ahead to Augusta National?

GARY WOODLAND: Randy's got me in a spot now, my game's better than it's ever been. Obviously I've got to battle some stuff with that, but my game, he's more than a golf coach to me. And Steiny, he's been with me through all this. I love him to death.
