Q. Man of the hour for the PGA TOUR, Ken Tackett. We've been full of updates today trying to get this third round in. What is the latest you can tell us? Are you going to send the guys home or do we have any more hope for today?

We're going to resume Round 3 at 7:45 and what we'll do is with the time allotted, we'll just keep the groups together.

Q. Have all the Tour players been super nice to you today, Ken?

KEN TACKETT: Absolutely. Everybody knows that Mother Nature's undefeated. Your comments earlier were spot on.
