**CHARLIE WI** (-12)



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**Q. Charlie, great round. Just sort of take us through the start. I think it was, what, three or four birdies in a row to start?**

I took a cart today and it was really nice. We really got lucky with the weather today where we didn't get any rain. Hopefully it will stay dry. I know the last couple years it's been really wet out here, so it will be nice for the fans to have a dry golf course to walk around in.

**Q. What is it about this course that you like?**

**CHARLIE WI:** I don't know. I'm doing the same thing, but for some reason I feel like I read the greens a little bit better. I really struggled on the greens last week and the week before, but I feel pretty comfortable on the greens around here.

**Q. You've got a guy in front of you who's on a hot streak.**

**CHARLIE WI:** Yeah.

**Q. You know that. You're going to be with him more than likely tomorrow. What is it like playing with somebody like that?**

**CHARLIE WI:** Well, Stewart, he's been playing amazing, and to keep it at that level for so long, that is pretty impressive. We played on the Tour quite a few times, but not out here. Looking forward to watching his game. I know he hits it a million miles. So he's going to play his own game and I have to stick to my game plan.
