LUCAS GLOVER (-7)



Q. Lucas, two birdies to close up another really good round, 63. If we can get some comments on your play.

LUCAS GLOVER: Yeah, it was a good start obviously. Very similar to last week, the first couple days, hit it nice, made some putts and no bogeys. Always a good way to start.

First time here at this course. Absolutely love it. Wish we played more like it, to be fair. Very, very happy with the way I played. Enjoy the course, enjoying Louisville. Yeah, all good.

Q. You're not the first that we've heard say that. What is it about the golf course that you like so much?

LUCAS GLOVER: It's just fair. I remember watching it from Scotland last year, it was firm and fast and scores were high. This year it's soft because of the rain so scores are low and that's the way it should be. I feel like too many people try to play God with the golf courses and set 'em up a certain way. This one, the conditions determine what the scores are going to be and that's how it should be.

Great mix of holes, great mix of par 3s. It's just really good. I wish we played a lot more like it.

Q. Seventeen of 18 greens, not to shabby, great ball-striking.

LUCAS GLOVER: I didn't know that, but OK. That's good, that's good, I'll take that.

Yeah, I've been hitting it good for a couple weeks. I found a little something Sunday morning in Hartford before I played and took it to the Deere and brought it here and it just seems to be clicking. I need to hit a few more fairways rest of the week. I missed several fairways with fairway woods, which is unlike me, so got to clean that up a little bit. But I'll work on that in the morning. Too hot to work on it tonight.

Q. Yeah, eight straight rounds in the 60s now on Tour. Just talk a little bit about how fun golf is for you right now.

LUCAS GLOVER: It's good. It was a struggle leading up to last week obviously, but I seem to like it when it gets real hot. Yeah, it's fun. You see putts go in, you get a good bounce instead of a bad bounce, ball starts rolling towards the hole instead of away from it, feel like you can do anything. It was a good week last week, it's starting this week and it's going to take more of the same.



Q. 583 starts, Lucas, is that number just mind boggling to you?

LUCAS GLOVER: Yeah, it is. I didn't know it was that many now.

I remember my first one. I remember my 500th, and sounds like I'll get 600 next year, I hope. When I think I'm cool, I still think Jay Haas has made more cuts than events I've played, which is remarkable. You know, in my 23rd year out here, I wouldn't trade it for the world. I do what I love, love what I do, love to practice and compete. I just love playing golf.
