STEVEN FISK (-11)



Q. Steven, clean scorecard today with four birdies, 66. How did that round differ from yesterday's round when you started with a bogey but poured on the birdies?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah, didn't have those five birdies in a row today to kind of get started. Other than that, honestly I felt like I probably played a little bit better today than I did yesterday. Didn't have to rely on my putter quite as hard until kind of middle of that back nine. Felt like I hit a lot of really good iron shots, pretty good speed on the greens. Just trying to leave myself not a lot of stress out there.

Q. Were you happy with that score or do you feel a little disappointed just coming in? Looked like you had a couple of good makeable chances on the last three or four holes.

STEVEN FISK: I hit a couple of good putts on 7 and 8, unfortunately I haven't gotten either of those to start this week. That's fine. The greens can get a little chewed up late in the day and all you can do is hit the best putt you can and hope it goes in.

Q. You mentioned in a prior interview about trying to stay away from looking at stats, but can you just elaborate, tell that story and what happened?

STEVEN FISK: Yeah. My psychologist and I talked about not looking at stats. There's really only one stat that matters and that's what you shot that day. Been trying my hardest to stay away from those and my mom sent me a video last night with the highlights from Round 1 and first thing the video said was Steven Fisk gained three-point-whatever shots putting the first day. So I tried to kind of block that out, not really worry about it. I think I putted all right today, too. We'll find out Sunday night when I look at it.

Q. Did you give your mom the news?

STEVEN FISK: No, no, no, I didn't say anything. Not a big deal.

Q. What are you looking forward to come the weekend after following your career low round with this round today? What are you looking forward to on the weekend now?

STEVEN FISK: Honestly, more of the same. I felt like I drove the ball a little better today. I feel like if I can drive it well, put the ball in the fairway, I think my iron game's starting to come around a little bit and I'm giving myself plenty of chances to have a chance come Sunday afternoon.
