JACKSON KOIVUN (-5)



Q. Looks like you're going to obviously make the cut and it'll be your first as a professional, but what a finish to do it. Just talk us through that situation maybe, the last three birdies in the last three holes but where you were with maybe five or six holes to go.

JACKSON KOIVUN: Yeah, I was definitely stressing. I knew the cut was going to be probably around 2 or 3 and I made a bad bogey on my fifth hole maybe. Just kind of hit me like OK, we've got to pedal down and do some work. I knew we had a reachable par 5 and somewhat reachable par 4 on 8, and the long putt on 9 was the cherry on top.

Q. You've experienced a lot of exciting things in golf. It may not seem the same as some other things that you've experienced, but it's got to be a pretty nice feeling for you to have achieved that right now at this point.

JACKSON KOIVUN: Oh, 100 percent. It feels great to finally make my first cut as a professional. Like I talked about earlier this week, last week stung and just trying to work out some kinks with my golf swing. Not fully out, but just get some work in this afternoon and be ready to go make a chase on moving day.

Q. What sort of work do you think you'll do on the range this afternoon?

JACKSON KOIVUN: I've really got to hone in on my start lines, I've been leaving a lot out to the right. Just some distance work with my wedges. Ball's been going really far off this grass and just how hot it is, and then the rain's kind of thrown us for a loop because it was pretty firm in our practices and now it's been spinning back a lot, so working on a little more of those off-speed wedges and dialing in some numbers.

Q. What's the most exciting thing you're going to look forward to this weekend then?

JACKSON KOIVUN: Just seeing how far I can get up the leaderboard.
