STEPHAN JAEGER (-13)



Q. Stephan, 5-under 65, if we can get some comments on your round.

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah, nice round. You know, you start off 1 and 3, pretty hard holes, even 5 is a tough one, 6 is a tough one. So it's hard to kind of get a lot of birdies early.

I kind of stayed patient early and made some putts kind of starting on 6, made a nice putt there, and made birdie on the par 5 and the next short one.

So got a nice rhythm there in the middle of my round and then the end part, once again I didn't hit it close enough to really give myself a good birdie chance, but overall really happy with my round.

Q. Leading the round in Strokes Gained Tee to Green and also Approach to Greens. Good ball-striking today?

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah, no, I gave myself a lot of opportunities, made some nice putts. But I definitely kept it in front of me, hit a lot of nice iron shots on the holes that you need to, hit a couple wedges close and made a couple putts. Yeah, absolutely.

Q. What were the conditions like? I know we got a lot of rain overnight, ball in hand today, but talk a little bit about the conditions.

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah, the golf course obviously got a lot of rain this week. It was probably the right decision, it's pretty wet. Still in great shape. No wind today, it was pretty benign, to be honest with you. Ball in hand, no wind makes the fairways a little bigger, greens a little bigger. That's probably why you're seeing the scores you are this week, for sure. I know it had some teeth last year, so probably won't see that tomorrow.

Q. Yeah, first time for you at this course. What do you think so far?

STEPHAN JAEGER: It's great. It fits my eye well. The greens are kind of small, undulating, so it's a good golf course for me. I feel comfortable with some of the sightlines. Yeah, I like the golf course a lot.

Q. Had three top-25 finishes in your last five starts, so trending here. Just talk a little bit about what it's going to take to get another PGA TOUR victory and how this week can set you up for the rest of the year.

STEPHAN JAEGER: Yeah, it takes a lot of good golf, for sure. There's a lot of good golfers



there on top of the leaderboard.

I know Lucas has been playing some really, really good golf in the last two weeks. Has he made a bogey yet? It would be hard to catch him if he doesn't make a bogey.

I know I'm going to have to go out there and make some birdies tomorrow. You've got to be careful though because there is a lot of trouble kind of around those greens. They're elevated so you have to kind of pick and choose your battles there. Another good round tomorrow, I've got a chance, but definitely need some help.
