MAX HOMA (-7)



Q. Max, can you just summarize your overall experience being in Louisville and being at this tournament for the first time and what you thought of the golf course?

MAX HOMA: Yeah. The course is great. It's a shame with all the rain, it just never really stopped. Course is cool, it's a good layout. For an opposite field event, it's a lovely golf course. Yeah, I think it's a good test and has enough hard holes, so it was good to be out here.

Q. I think the fans appreciated you being out here. What do you have to say about the people of Louisville?

MAX HOMA: Yeah, it was fun. Like I said the other day, there's a ton of kids, which is the coolest part for us walking a bunch of holes and you can put yourself in their shoes, which is sweet. Yeah, I mean, just all the crowd, for how hot it was and not great weather, just how many people that came out to watch some golf was awesome.

Q. And then last one, you talked with like JT earlier in the week and reached out to some players about what to expect this week. What would you tell other prospective players that might be coming here in the future?

MAX HOMA: Yeah, it's a great golf course. Again, it's a good test. I think if you play well, your results will show. If you swing the club well and controlling your distances, you'll be able to kind of shoot yourself up the board. So it's not kind of just like a birdie-fest this week. There was a lot more just because of how soft it was, but in general, especially if there was an ounce of bounce to it, you would have to hit some really quality shots just to have decent looks.

Yeah, I think it's a good spot to come and play and compete, and if you're feeling good, I feel like you can come out here and do some good work.

Q. Max, where do you feel like your overall game is right now? Do you feel like you took more steps in the right direction this week?

MAX HOMA: Yeah, scoring was bad this week, I didn't seem to match it up. Yesterday, played awesome, short game was bad. Today, short game was awesome and then didn't hit it very well on the back nine. The game feels good, it just has to get sharper.

Q. Now, you mentioned JT earlier in the week. Did you take him up on his offer?



MAX HOMA: No. I'm going to the British Open tonight.

Q. Mentioning the British Open, you mentioned earlier in the week that you had an ugly or not-so-great flight. What's the next 24 hours look like for you now, and I'm sure you're pretty happy to actually be done today given --

MAX HOMA: Yeah, barring any delays or whatever, hopefully we would get there I think at like 4:00 on Monday. So it's not too bad, just two connectors. Just got to hope for just some decent weather I guess. Once we get to the second flight and we get over across the pond, we can manage regardless.
