BOO WEEKLEY (-9)



Q. Overall, what are the emotions on just hitting fairways and scrambling your way through?

BOO WEEKLEY: I didn't hit many fairways the last two days, but I made a lot of putts. That's what kept me in the game this week, putt the ball real well and my caddie helped me read the greens real well. We just executed on that end of it and everything panned out like it should. I'm very fortunate that -- I didn't even know I was in second place, I thought I had like tied for third or something.

Q. Ninth hole on was just a clean card, you were just making, capitalizing, capitalizing. What struck you from that ninth hole on?

BOO WEEKLEY: I would have to say the putt on 10 is what got me kind of really going because I felt like I had to make I think it was about a 15-foot sweeper and it dribbled in. I mean, when it went in, it was kind of like all right, I got a feeling now with my putter, it feels pretty good, we've just got to keep the lines. That's what we did. That's how we ended up shooting what we shot on the back side.

Q. Obviously a regular here at Firestone. Just what are your memories when you think of this course and what it means to you?

BOO WEEKLEY: This place has always beaten me up. This is the first time I've beat it up, it really is. You look at all the years I've played here, this is the first time I beat it up.

Q. You hit this golf course right there today, maybe not with your best stuff and I think that says a lot about the way you're playing.

BOO WEEKLEY: Yeah, it does. I did not have my A-game by no means. I played a couple holes where I hit it good and I played a couple holes where I couldn't find the fairways, got the pull looks. But that's golf, you know, and you've got to learn to maintain and figure out how you can just get it in the hole at fast as you can.

Q. And how did you do that because you ended up finishing second by yourself.

BOO WEEKLEY: Oh, really, I didn't even know that. I didn't look at the board to see where I was at. I thought Jimenez was at 9.
