DAVIS BRYANT (-15)



Q. Davis, kind of a tale of two nines today, 66 overall. How would you assess your round?

DAVIS BRYANT: Phenomenal, yeah. Always great to finish strong on Sunday, so super pleased with obviously the front nine. I mean, get some momentum, every putt just seemed to go in. The hole starts to look like a basketball hoop really.

Yeah, those are fun. I'm super happy. First time in the Dominican Republic for me and excited to come back next year hopefully.

Q. Seven consecutive birdies on the front there, that's a tournament record and career-best birdie streak for you. Can you just talk us through that whole stretch there?

DAVIS BRYANT: Kind of fell on a lot of good numbers where it was just either a full 8-iron or a full pitching wedge or something like that. Felt good with the putter. I was telling you on the way here, like I just kind of fell asleep and started hitting good shots and good putts and everything just seemed to go in. Super fun.

Q. Making the turn you were only one shot off the lead. Did you expect to jump into contention like that at any point?

DAVIS BRYANT: Not really, no. I just wanted to probably shoot 4, 5 under today was probably the goal and finish on a strong note. Excited for three weeks off at home coming up, so just wanted to leave feeling good really.

Q. After that birdie stretch did you think maybe you had a shot at winning the whole thing?

DAVIS BRYANT: Possibly, yeah, but there's so much golf for these guys to play. The front nine's obviously a little bit easier than the back nine. Those par 5s are tricky, 12, 13, 14 are difficult holes and then the finish is really challenging. I thought if I post a good number. I mean, starting the day at 9 under you're a bit too far back, but yeah, 15 under's really solid and super happy with it.

Q. What does a round like today do for your confidence?

DAVIS BRYANT: Yeah, I think it's been probably maybe six weeks since I've been in this situation, kind of playing really well and up near the top. Haven't played great the last four or



five weeks. Made some cuts but just kind of average. So I think getting in that mode again is great. Yeah, excited for the rest of the year across the pond.
