DAVIS THOMPSON (-6)



Q. Davis, 6-under 64, really solid round today. Just what were you most happy about your play today?

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah, I made five pars to start out. I was real patient with myself. Then birdied 15 and kind of took off from there. Hit a lot of quality iron shots. Set myself up to not really be in trouble all day today, then made some putts on top of that. It was just an overall solid day.

Q. Talk about that birdie streak you went on, six holes back to back.

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah. You know, I think the longest putt I had was around eight feet, so I was just hitting a lot of quality iron shots. Yeah, it was just nice to see the putts go in as well. Yeah, it was a nice little stretch there.

Q. You're coming off two top-10s. How do you feel like your game has been trending heading into this week?

DAVIS THOMPSON: Yeah, oddly enough, feel like ever since John Deere I feel like been doing some good stuff. Just got to be patient with myself mentally. Feel like I'm just trying to take a challenge not to let my mind beat me out there and just stay present and patient.

Yeah, I mean, obviously hitting it better, making more putts helps, but got to be mentally strong too. I feel like I've done that the last couple weeks.

Q. Anything you've been doing differently that you attribute the run to?

DAVIS THOMPSON: No, not really. I mean, sometimes you just have to be patient with yourself. Start to make a couple putts here or there and next thing you know, your confidence starts increasing and then you just kind of go from there.

Q. How much is the FedExCup Playoffs on your mind?

DAVIS THOMPSON: I mean, it's obviously like something everybody wants to make the Playoffs. With the position I'm in, I can't put too much emphasis on it. I just have to go execute golf shots and try to put good rounds together and hopefully by the end of the week I'm inside that number.
