MICHAEL BRENNAN (-22)



Q. Michael, you just looked at me and said, "Way better than the last couple of weeks." You said in order to turn those close calls into a win today, you had to stay in the present moment. How were you able to successfully do that today?

MICHAEL BRENNAN: I did it great for nine holes. I felt really good on the front nine just playing my game. I was really staying within myself, hitting good shots. Felt like I was really in control. Got a little nervous around 10, 11. I made a really nice par putt on 12 and that kind of steadied me a little bit going through. Just glad to make a few putts coming in.

Q. You told me you and Ollie were going to be working lockstep to keep those little goals to keep you focused. You guys had a really special moment right there. What did you say to him?

MICHAEL BRENNAN: Our goal on 16 tee was to birdie one out of the last three and play it 1 under, and that putt on 18 was to do it so that's what I was just repeating to him.

Q. Those five consecutive birdies on the front were good but it felt like the most important hole for you was 17. How deep did you have to dig on that approach shot and of course that par save?

MICHAEL BRENNAN: Oh, my gosh. Not a great swing, I wish I had that tee ball over again, but my ball was in a divot and I think that helped me a little bit because some of the rough is really nasty and the ball can sit down. So I could kind of get a somewhat clean shot on it. I'm lucky it went the right distance and had a crazy two-putt.

Q. Christiaan Bezuidenhout's divot by the way, so you might want to thank him for that eventually. But before we get there, let me be the first to officially welcome you to the FedExCup Playoffs. You started the week outside of 100, you work your way inside the top-50. What does it mean for you to get this done at this point in the season?

MICHAEL BRENNAN: It's everything. I don't want to be done playing golf. I feel like I've played the best golf I have all year the last couple weeks. Unfortunately, a couple tough Sundays. But outside of that, I've been playing really, really solid. I mean, this is my sixth week in a row so seven's a lot but I think I'm going to be perfectly happy running on fumes next week.
